The Student Learning Center, located in the Learning Resource Center, is an important resource for Odessa College students. The center includes: Tutoring Center, Basis Skills Lab and an open-access computer lab. Tutoring assistance is available for a variety of subjects, including college mathematics, writing, English, speech, and the various sciences. Assistance with developmental coursework is also available.

Tutoring, which is free of charge to Odessa College students, is conducted preferably by appointment (432-335-6878). Walk-ins are always welcomed, and

they will be served as quickly as possible.

Online tutoring is also available for Odessa College students. Call 432-335-6714 to make an appointment for online tutoring.

Peer mentoring is available to all OC students. Call 432-335-6714 to sign up.

Both the Basic Skills and the open-access computer labs have the Internet and Microsoft Office XP and 2007 available for student use. Additionally, the Basic Skills Lab has software resources to assist OC students to improve reading, writing, and mathematical skills. The Student Learning Center director (432-335-6714) is available to work with students on a variety of educational issues including: test anxiety, math anxiety, time management, critical thinking skill development, SQ3R, test taking skills, etc. Computer lab assistants are always available to assist students with computer and Internet usage and questions. All printing is free to students in the center.
