Odessa College enrollment numbers increase for summer 2008

ODESSA (July 17, 2008) – Odessa College’s summer 2008 enrollment numbers are 2,858 which is a 25.4 percent increase from summer 2007’s enrollment of 2,280 students. These enrollment numbers include the flex numbers.

Summer I 2008 enrollment was 1,607 which is a 24 percent increase from summer I 2007’s enrollment of 1,295. Summer II 2008’s enrollment is 1,251 which is a 27 percent increase from summer II 2007’s enrollment of 985.

“I’m very proud of our summer enrollment numbers. A more than 25 percent increase in enrollment from summer 2007 to summer 2008 is amazing,” said Dr. Gregory Williams, OC president. “OC continues to grow and do more, and Odessa College will continue to focus on providing more services and support to our students to help them succeed.”

Williams said Odessa College is thankful for the support of the community, board of trustees and OC employees and staff.
