OC photography students, faculty to display works at Texas Photographic Society “Members’ Only Exhibition”

ODESSA (Jan. 12, 2012) – Odessa College photography student and faculty works are now on display in the Texas Photographic Society “Members’ Only Exhibition,” a national competition, at Odessa College.

OC photography majors Rebecca Tucker, Gerardo Vasquez and Stephanie Lares along with OC photography chair Steve Goff have works in the exhibition.

The exhibit is a national photo competition juried by Henry Horenstein. Horenstein is a widely published and exhibited professional photographer and the author of more than two dozen books, including the classic texts “Black & White Photography,” “Beyond Basic Photography,” and “Color Photography,” and monographs such as “Creatures, Canine, and Racing Days.” His work has appeared in *Life*, *Newsweek*, *Vanity Fair*, and *Town & Country*. He has taught photography at the Rhode Island School of Design for more than 20 years and currently is a professor at RISD.

The exhibition will be on display now through Friday, March 9 in the Odessa College Options Gallery in the Murry H. Fly Learning Resources Center. Options Gallery hours are 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Friday and 2 to 5 p.m. Sunday.
