Your FAFSA was selected for a process called verification. The law says that before awarding federal student aid, your school may ask you to confirm the information that you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. Complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed. **The verification process may take several weeks.**

- parent(s)' other children (even if they do not live with a parent), if your parent(s) will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 or if the children would be required to provide parental information on a 2022-2023 FAFSA
- other people if they now live with your parent(s) and your parents provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Independent Students, as defined on the FAFSA, include:

- yourself and your spouse (if married)
- your children or spouse's children, if you will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 (even if they do not live with you).
- other people if they now live with you and you will provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Verification of 2020 IRS Income Tax Return Information for Tax Filers:

Tax return information must be provided for the student, the student's spouse and a dependent student's parents listed above. We cannot accept copies of the tax return and you must use one of the methods below. *If you have a filing extension, filed an amended tax return, filed outside the US or were the victim of IRS identity theft, contact OC Student Financial Aid.*

- **Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool:** go to www.FAFSA.gov, log in to your FAFSA record, select "Make FAFSA Corrections," and go to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2020 IRS income tax information into your FAFSA. *Your information will be available for the Data Retrieval Tool to use about 3 weeks after an electronic tax return was filed or about 8 weeks after a paper tax return was filed.*
- **Request 2020 IRS tax return transcript:** go to www.IRS.gov/transcript and click on the "Order a Return or Account Transcript" link, or call 1-800-908-9946. Make sure to request the "IRS tax return transcript" and **NOT** the "account transcript". *Your information will be available for a transcript about 3 weeks after an electronic tax return was filed or about 8 weeks after a paper tax return was filed.*
