Texas Grant & TEOG Eligibility Statement

TEXAS Grant and Texas Educational Opportunities Grant (TEOG) regulations mandate that students may not receive funds if they have been convicted of a felony involving a controlled substance and if they are delinquent in child support obligations. In the past, student eligibility was covered through a question on the FAFSA. The wording of that question has changed and no longer applies to the state grants so schools must now collect a statement from the students. You are eligible to receive a Texas Grant or TEOG. If you have work/study or a loan, your Texas Grant or TEOG funds MAY be used to reduce the loan or work/study. **To receive the funds, you must complete and return this form before January 15, to:**
