## Frequently Asked Questions

### ***What is the criteria to enroll in the Electrical Lineman Program?***

A passion/desire to become a skilled Electrical Lineman ready to enter the field after completion of the program

### ***What types of jobs will I be able to get after I am finished the program?***

Upon completion of the program, the following options in the field are available to participants ---telecommunications worker, power lineworker, journeyman lineworker, substation technician, cable splicer, utility worker and much more.

### ***How long will it take to complete the Electrical Lineman Program?***

- *The timeframe for completion is only 14 weeks, meeting three times a week--(Saturdays for 8 hours and two days a week for 4 hours each). Total of 224 hours*
- *We also intend on offering a more accelerated cohort for the Summer---6 weeks, meeting Monday – Friday for 40hrs each week. Total of 224 hours*

### ***What is the tuition cost and what will that cover?***

*Tuition per student is \$4800. Tuition covers all the materials, supplies/equipment participants will need. (Materials and Supplies include climbing boots, safety glasses, gloves and books)*

***What are the requirements for successful completion/graduation from the program?***

Attendance and participation at course sessions and completion of a Knowledge-Based Test and Proficiency Skills Practicum at the end of the course
