

Dates	Course Title	Course Description
Feb. 3-4, 2021 Mar. 15-16, 2021	IRRT-1	Industrial Rope Rescue Technician – Level 1 (Prerequisite: None) This 20-hour course covers the familiarity of industrial rescue equipment, the need for rescue services and enables the rescuer to assist other rescuers in the operation of lowering and haul systems, including mechanical advantage systems. Two Rope Systems are built and basic lowering and rappelling skills on multiple devices are covered.
Feb. 15-16, 2021 Mar. 30-31, 2021	IRRT-2	Industrial Rope Rescue Technician – Level 2 (Prerequisite: IRRT-1) This 20-hour course covers the two-rope rescue system, including fixed rope, top and bottom rope belay systems, redirecting anchors, pickoffs, mechanical advantage systems, ascending and descending past knots, mid-line transfers (aid climb rescues), patient packaging and troubleshooting on ropes.
Mar. 1-2, 2021 Apr. 19-20, 2021	IRRT-3	Industrial Rope Rescue Technician – Level 3 (Prerequisite: IRRT-2) This 20-hour course covers the construction and utilizing of horizontal and diagonal (Tyrolean and Telfer) tension line systems, Skate Block systems and deviations from Tension Lines. Tripod and A-Frame Operations are included.
Feb. 1-2, 2021 Mar. 22-23, 2021	PRCS-R1	Confined Space Rescue Technician – Level 1 (Prerequisite: None) This 20-hour course covers the requirements of the NFPA for certification in conducting non-entry retrievals and participating as an Operator in operating mechanical advantage systems. <i>This course alone does NOT qualify the rescuer to make Entry Rescues.</i>
Feb. 17-18, 2021 Apr. 5-6, 2021	PRCS-R2	Confined Space Rescue Technician – Level 2 (Prerequisites: PRCS-R1) This 20-hour course is designed for the planning, hazard mediation and execution of confined space rescues in horizontal and vertical vessels.
Mar. 3-4, 2021 Apr. 21-22, 2021	PRCS-R3	Confined Space Rescue Technician – Level 3 (Prerequisite: PRCS-R2) This 20-hour course covers multiple advanced scenarios and rescuers working under air to perform rescues, including Team Skills Training, Rappeler-Assisted Basket Lowers and other scenarios.
Feb. 8-9, 2021 Mar. 24-25, 2021	VRT-1	Vertical Rescue Technician – Level 1 (No Prerequisite) A 20-hour Basic Level course for Fire Department personnel , the VRT1 course covers basic rappelling, ascending, rescue rigging and equipment needed in rescue operations.
Feb. 24-25, 2021	VRT-2	Vertical Rescue Technician – Level 2 (Prerequisite VRT1) A 20-hour Intermediate Level course for Fire Department personnel , the VRT2 course covers Access, Stabilize and quick Transport. Topics include double rope belays, mechanical advantage, ascending changeover, victim harnesses, advanced anchors, rescue baskets, patient packaging, load releasing hitches, slope evacuations, night skills and knot passing on line.
Mar. 17-18, 2021	VRT-3	Vertical Rescue Technician – Level 3 (Prerequisite VRT 2) A 20-hour Advanced Level course for Fire Department personnel , the VRT3 course covers Stabilize and Transport of the injured, haul systems, vertical and horizontal rescue baskets, high line options, patient /rescuer on line, troubleshooting, and advanced scenarios.

<p>Apr. 12-16, 2021</p>	<p>WaH-50</p>	<p>Working at Heights (Prerequisite: None) A 50-hour course designed for those who may work at heights for painting, inspections, installations and other work assignments while on rope systems, and includes rescue techniques of a suspended person. Two Rope Systems, JSA / Risk Assessments, Ascending, Descending, Re-Belays, Deviations and Rope to Rope Transfers and Pickoffs of a Suspended Person. On the final day, very strict skills evaluations are completed based on scenario instructions given by the Instructor. This course does not teach a trade, but the ropes systems that are needed to perform the task.</p>
<p>Feb. 11, 2021 Mar. 29, 2021</p>	<p>PRCS-HRO</p>	<p>Confined Space Rescue – Horizontal Rescue Only A 10-hour course covering the provisions of the NFPA 1006, Sections 7.2.9 through 7.2.11 and satisfies the requirements for the Tier 2 System rating of Occidental Petroleum.</p>
<p>Feb. 22-23, 2021 Apr. 7-8, 2021</p>	<p>WWT</p>	<p>Window Washer Technician Course (Prerequisite – None) A 20-hour course from Rescue Training International for those who may provide cleaning and maintenance services while working at heights. This course only certifies the Attendee for window washing job assignments and covers self-rescue procedures only.</p>
<p>Feb. 10, 2021 Mar. 30, 2021 Apr. 27, 2021</p>	<p>IST-1</p>	<p>Individual Skills Training (Prerequisite – any RTI certifications) A “Rope Day” set aside each month, for up to 8 hours, to allow RTI certified rescuers to come to the facility(ies) to work individual skills, be trained in new equipment they may have purchased, get advice on rigging procedures or to use the facility to pre-plan rigging / rescue plans / risk assessments for a pending rescue job. No additional certs are given.</p>
