



## Instruction and Answer Sheet

1. **(2<sup>nd</sup> Floor) Clue A:** Look on the column between the four public computers and answer the questions below.

- Under **Basic Search** type in a topic from the list below. (Make sure to type “ ” if shown). Then click on the **Search Button**.

- On the next screen choose one of the ebooks and click on the blue link **View this eBook**.

- Double click the icon for Internet Explorer. This will bring up the LRC home page. (URL for LRC home page: <http://www.odessa.edu/dept/library>).
- Click on **Article Research**.
- Click on **General Topics** select "**Wilson Select Plus**".
- Click on the dark blue arrow in a blue box by the "**Select a topic or database**". Arrow down till you find "**WilsonSelectPlus**", then click on it.
- Then click in the box by "**Search For:**". Type in a subject from the list below. Click on the button "**Search**".
