The following must be contained in the applicant's file:	
	Completed admissions application online through Apply Texas. Be sure to select the two-year international application  Non-refundable application fee: \$50 (US currency – cash, debit/credit or cashier's check accepted)  Copy(ies) of passport information (name, passport number, address, etc.) in color.  Official high school/secondary school transcript or college(s)/university(ies), if applicable. Transcripts must be translated into English. A list of Foreign Credential Evaluation Services is included.  Official test score report of demonstrated English language proficiency. Acceptable tests, official score reports and/or course work that a student from a non-English speaking country can submit for consideration are as follows:
	<ul> <li>Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a minimum score of 525 on the paper test or 61 on the Internet-based test.</li> <li>International English Language Testing System (IELTS) - minimum score of 6</li> <li>Duolingo English Test - minimum score of 85</li> <li>TSI Assessment - A minimum English Language Arts and Reading multiple choice score of 940 and a minimum essay score of 4</li> <li>SAT - minimum score of 480 on the critical reading or Evidence-Based Reading and Writing test (EBRW)</li> <li>ACT - minimum score of 19 on the English test</li> <li>CLEP - minimum score of 50 with essay on the English test</li> <li>International Baccalaureate Program - minimum score of 4 on the English A1 Higher Level (HL) exam</li> <li>Two consecutive years of English at the secondary/high school or college/university level with a passing grade &amp; a minimum score on one of the approved tests outlined above may also be submitted for consideration.</li> </ul>
	A physician's statement showing <u>proof of immunization</u> against diphtheria & tetanus within the last 10 years.  All first-time students under the age of 22 must have the bacterial meningitis vaccination.  A negative result on a tuberculosis test and evidence of good physical health.  Financial statement showing proof of funds to cover \$17,000 per calendar year to cover educational and living expenses. Add \$5,000 for each additional dependent.  Proof of medical insurance including evacuation/repatriation. Verification is required for each semester of enrollment.
