



Odessa College ADN Program Application Checklist

Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Applications must be submitted with all required components in PDF format upon submission to the nursing program.

- ☐ Meet with School of Health & Sciences Academic Success Coach to complete the Transcript Checklist PRIOR to application submission. The checklist is located with the program application. *Required prerequisites must be taken prior to application to the program.*
 - BIOL 2401- must be a "C" or better and taken within 5 years of application
 - BIOL 2402- must be a "C" or better and taken within 5 years of application
 - ENGL 1301
 - HUMA (1305, 2319 or 2323 choice of one) Please speak with your Success Coach about approved substitutions
 - PSYC 2314 (PSYC 2301 can be substituted)
- ☐ Attend a MANDATORY Information Session for the current application cycle PRIOR to application submission
- ☐ ADN application and Transcript Checklist
- ☐ Copies of college transcripts (official copies do not have to be submitted to the program)
- ☐ HESI Scores (expires after 2 years)
 - Minimum Reading score 78%
 - Minimum Grammar score 78%
 - Minimum Math score 78%
 - Minimum Anatomy & Physiology score 78%
 - Critical Thinking- points given based on score
- ☐ Enrolled as a current Odessa College student and have a high school diploma or GED
 - Must submit all previous official transcripts to Odessa College Records Office
- ☐ Current LVN License (if applying for the Transition program)

Health record components are **NOT** required to be submitted for application to the program. However, applicants are strongly encouraged to submit all health record documents if they have them. Please refer to the ADN Admissions Guide for more information.

Applications Accepted:

- Traditional Program (Main Campus): May 1st – end of Maymester term. Check date on the OC Associate Degree Nursing website, the Nursing office, or your Success Coach
- Spring Transition Cohort (Andrews Location): October 1st – October 20th



- Summer Transition Cohort (Main Campus): March 1st – March 20th
