Odessa College RN to BSN Program Pre-Admission Checklist

The following must be complete for your application to be considered complete:

1. Complete Odessa College admission process. Contact Odessa College advising center or admission and enrollment center to complete admission.
2. Submit a **complete** RN to BSN program application. Note: Application must be pdf fillable document NOT handwritten.
3. Odessa College will honor Applied Associate in Science (AAS) in Nursing from other Community Colleges (**provide official or unofficial transcripts**) with your application.
4. Applicants must have at least a “C” in all previous nursing coursework AND must have an overall GPA of 2.5 in all nursing coursework.
5. Must have a minimum of 90 semester credit hours from general education pre-requisite courses **plus** Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) courses prior to acceptance.
6. Applicants must complete all prerequisite courses with minimum GPA of 2.5 and a C or higher in each course AND an overall GPA of 2.5 prior to applying for your application to be considered. See program admission guide or program website for a list of all pre-requisite courses.
7. Applicants **must have an unencumbered current Texas RN license OR Compact multistate license** * applicants with pending license will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
8. Applicants must have a minimum of one letter of recommendation from a previous nursing faculty member or a current employer.
9. Applicants must be able to complete their clinical hours either within the state of Texas OR in the state where they currently practice.
10. Personal Statement Essay/Letter of Intent.
11. Meet the Technical Standards required by the program.
